



Website & Social Media Policy & Guidelines

Magnum FSC uses the internet to publicise themselves and keep in contact with those interested in the sport. However, Magnum FSC is mindful in how they present themselves online and the risks the internet can pose to young people if not used appropriately. 'Social media' is the common term used for web-based tools that allow us to interact with each other in some way, by sharing information, opinions, knowledge and interests online. It falls on the Club Committee to safeguard against potential risks inherent in using these mediums, ensuring they are controlled effectively to avoid any legal and ethical issues arising, and to maintain our reputation in good standing.

We have produced these best practice principles in line with NISA guidelines on website/social media networking.

- When signing membership forms or joining SkateUK, you agree to our terms and conditions regarding posting of images on our webpage and social media.
- If you do not wish your child's images to be displayed you will be asked to sign a waiver.
- The Facebook and website should portray a professional image, ensuring all language and content is appropriate.
- No comments should be posted that bring the club into disrepute in any way.
- NO abusive language or bullying, nor any offensive or defamatory comments about the Club or individuals, will be tolerated, and shall be promptly removed. The individuals responsible will be reprimanded.
- Members of the committee are responsible for ensuring that the Club's website and social media pages are managed correctly.
- Only members of the committee may post material on these sites.
- All content, links and profiles will be regularly monitored to ensure they are appropriate and working.
- Reporting of any problems or concerns should be undertaken by following the link for messaging on the sites.
- If Magnum FSC becomes aware of problems such as cyber bullying or a young person placing themselves at risk with the information they share on the internet, they will follow the set procedures for concerns or contact a help organisation for advice;
- Committee members and our Child Protection Officer contact details will be displayed on our webpage.
- No personal information will be displayed on our sites of any of our members, i.e. no email address, home address, school attended etc.



- Information and images you wish posted on our sites, can be relayed to us via the link for sending messages on the sites, or by contacting us below.
- Parents and skaters are encouraged to view our website and Facebook page regularly, and to send us relevant images and information to be posted.
- This policy, as with all our policies and procedures, will be reviewed regularly by the committee, to ensure that we are providing the most effective and safe practices to our members.
